MERN MONOGRAPH SERIES II CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The Manitoba Education Research Network (MERN) has established the *MERN Monograph Series II*. This series publishes one or two monographs a year on research that is relevant to Manitoba education, comes from work in Manitoba schools, and is of interest to Manitoba educators. Its purpose is to contribute to: public education in the province; the professional knowledge base of educators in the province; and, national and international awareness of Manitoba educational research. It provides an opportunity to feature graduate, postgraduate and teacher education research.

The monograph should be between 40 and 80 pages in length to be published in hard copy and electronically. Editorial control for the series resides with an editorial board made up of the Deans from each of Manitoba's Faculties of Education, a Senior Editor from the Faculty of Education, University of Manitoba, and the Director of the Manitoba Education Research Network. The monograph will be reviewed by members of the MERN Editorial Review Committee prior to release as a refereed publication.
